Based in Toronto, Grenville Strategic Royalty Corp. is a publicly-traded royalty company that makes investments in established businesses with strong growth, recurring/predictable revenues and the ability to raise capital from multiple sources. Grenville generates revenues from royalty payments and Contract Buyouts. The non-dilutive royalty financing structure offered by Grenville competes directly with traditional equity to meet the long-term financing needs of companies on more attractive commercial terms. As of June 30, 2017, Grenville has generated cash inflows of \$41.2 million from \$68.2 million invested since its inception.

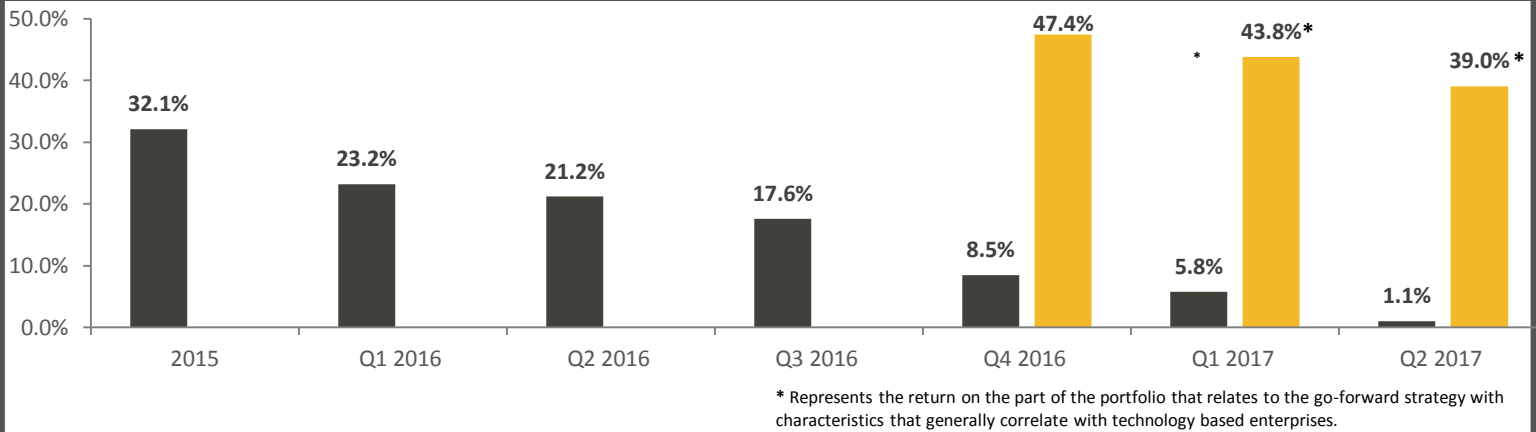

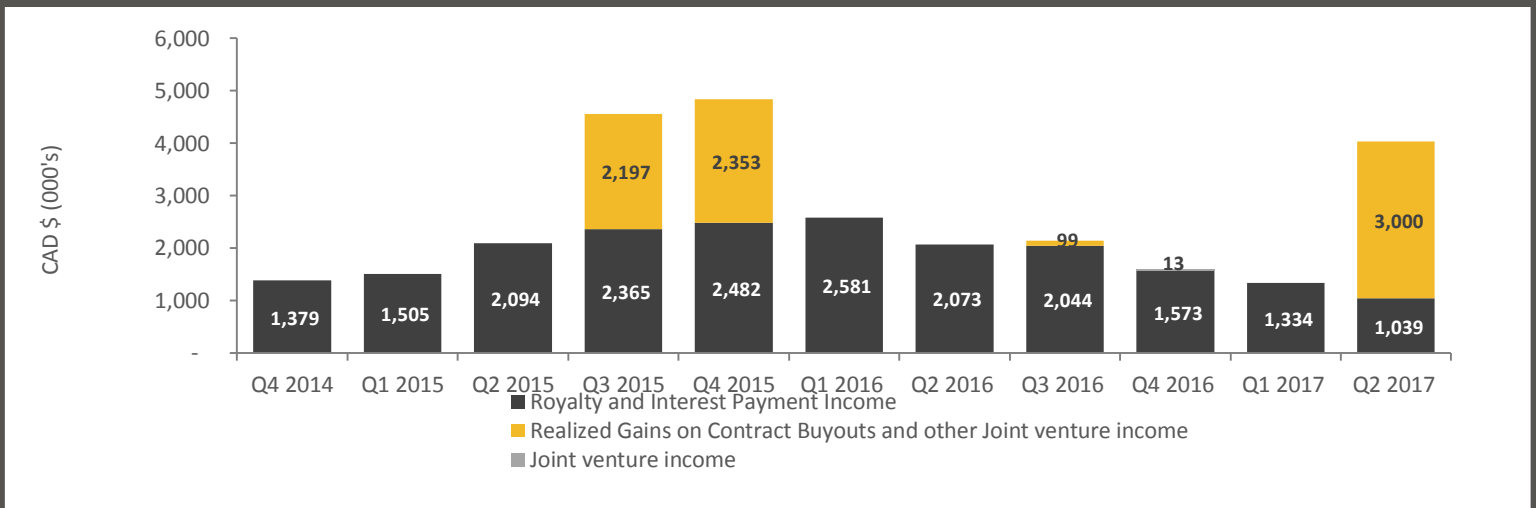

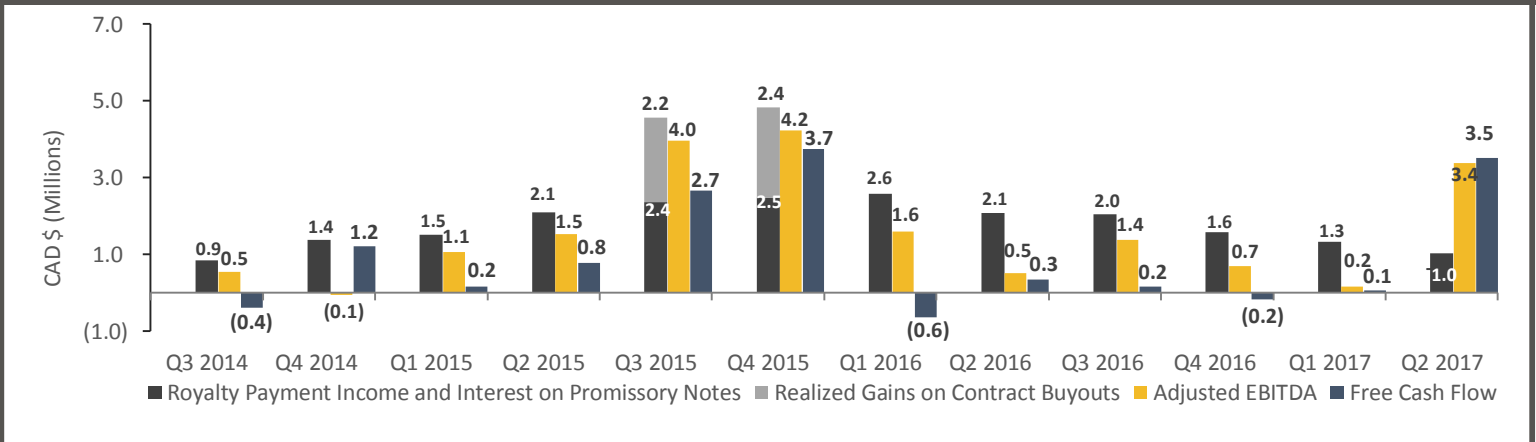
PORTFOLIO IRR
